INSTRUCTION No 8

From 27th of November 2018

related to the interpretation of the provisions of the Project Implementation Manual regarding the extension of the implementation period for the projects on the Concept Note phase

Taking into account the provisions of:

- ✓ Guide for Applicants for Strategic Projects, Restricted Call 1, version 1.3. Investment Priority IP 7/b: Enhancing regional mobility by connecting secondary and tertiary nodes to Ten-T infrastructure, including multimodal nodes,
- ✓ Project Implementation Manual, version 3

Taking into account the indication of a project whose implementation period is lower than the one stipulated in the Guide for Applicants for Strategic Projects, Restricted Call 1, version 1.3 - for the Concept Note stage, it is necessary to clarify a provision of the Project Implementation Manual,

Taking into account the written agreement of the Hungarian National Authority on the interpretation of the provisions of the Project Implementation Manual,

1. The Managing Authority for the Interreg V-A Romania - Hungary Program issues the following **Instruction**:

The provision of the Project Implementation Manual, version 3 (Footnote, p. 25), according to which the extension of the implementation period is not accepted in the Concept Note phase, shall be interpreted in conjunction with the provisions of Chapter 2, subchapter 2.1, paragraph 3 of the Guide for Applicants for Strategic Projects, Restricted Call 1, version 1.3 (page 19), as follows:

The projects in the Concept Note phase can be extended to the maximum of the implementation period, according to the provisions of the Guide for Applicants, respectively up to a maximum of 6 (six) months of implementation.

2. The provisions of this Instruction shall enter into force on the date of its approval by the Head of MA.
