TO BENEFICIARIES

of Interreg V-A Romania-Hungary Programme
regarding reimbursement of expenditures

Acknowledging a need for extended flexibility towards a better assistance to beneficiaries and greater efficiency of Programme implementation,

Taking into consideration the decommitment target for 2019 and possible financial corrections in case of deviations,

Having regard to provisions of subsidy and national co-financing contracts referring to Rights and duties of the parties, the Managing Authority issues the following:

INSTRUCTION TO BENEFICIARIES

- Article 1 - All partners have the obligation to submit **interim partner reports**, if they include costs of at least **2000 euro**. The reports will be submitted to FLC until **October 15th, 2019**, the latest.
- Article 2 - All Lead Partners are allowed to submit unlimited **interim project (consolidated) reports**, even for every FLC certificate issued, if the validated amount is at least 2000 euro. The project reports covering costs already validated by FLC, should be submitted to JS as soon as the FLC certificate is issued.
- Article 3 - The **regular reporting obligations (without financial impact)**, as provided by the subsidy contracts, are **suspended** until December 31st, 2019. Technical progress at project level will be reflected in the following project report.
- Article 4 - Submission of **technical modification requests** will be limited to **1 per reporting period**, until December 31st, 2019.
- Article 5 - The present instruction shall enter into force on the day it is published and it will be communicated:
- to all Beneficiaries, by the Joint Secretariat (JS) from BRECO (via email),
 - via postage on the Programme's website by the Joint Secretariat (JS) within BRECO.
