Summary	 The PPs wish to address the following challenges in the eligible area: old or missing mobility infrastructure in the CB area, causing fragmentation The project's main activities are: construction of 12.14 km of new roads in Arad County modernization of 20.06 km of roads in Arad County preparation of 43 technical designs and studies in Bekes County Main expected results of the project are the following: Modernized road DJ 709B Curtici-Sanmartin and Sanmartin – Socodor; New constructed road DJ 792 Socodor-Nadab and South-North Motorway Bypass, City of Curtici; Elaboration of studies regarding the traffic in the border area. The selected roads will improve mobility for passengers and freight, connecting the localities to the TEN-T infrastructure while tackling the challenges of an increased traffic in the area.
