	<p>bootcamps meaning online simulation-based intensive training camp for 100 students (1 in RO and 2 in HU);</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 cross-border strategy which includes a baseline report about the four counties of the project area and an Integrated development strategy • 1 Caravan was organized by LB, with an expert speaker on entrepreneurship – visiting 6 cities in the four counties (and more than 8 high schools) • 2-day Cross-border teacher workshop organized for 15 teachers in Romania so they could learn about the current and most effective tools and methods of entrepreneurship education; <p>The Programme Output Indicator is „CO44 Labour Market and Training: Number of participants in joint local employment initiatives and joint training”.
