Summary	The project ROHU 54 aims a new partnership for cross-border cooperation between Zerind Village and Újkígyós Town in the field of risk management and prevention such as wildfires, fires, storms, etc.

	Through the project ROHU-54, 28,154 persons are better-protected
	inhabitants as a result of its implementation.
Main results	The project results are related to the increased common capacity for risk prevention and disaster management through the specific equipment. Thus, 14,474 people in the Zerind area and 13,680 people in the Újkígyós area benefit from better-equipped emergency intervention services. Firefighters in the area have a common plan for prevention and mitigation of risks and increase their level of training by participating in joint training sessions and simulation exercises. All this contributes to increasing the quality of the cross-border risk management and disaster management system.
