Summary	The ROHU80 project facilitates cross-border risk management by improving the infrastructure, equipment and human potential serving the emergency response teams in Satu Mare and Szabolcs-Szatmár-Bereg counties. The main activities are: • Purchasing equipment for "Cross-border integrated monitoring, risk prevention and disaster management centre" (2 medium-sized fire-engine for fire extinction and extrication, 12 complete equipment for firefighters, 4 intelligent alarming system, 1 large-sized (5000 l) fire-engine for fire extinction and extrication with
	complete equipment for 6 firefighters, 2 extrication sets, 1 moto- pump, 2 medium-sized fire-engine 2500 l with mandatory equipment)







- Organizing a 3 days "Field study and networking" camp by Odoreu
- Organizing joint trainings and practices (simulation of a technological accident, a road accident, an ecological accident, on population evacuation, joint exercise on forest fire, on giving "First aid"), bringing together a significant number of professionals and voluntary, to share their experience for facilitating harmonized interventions
- Organizing Awareness raising campaign on emergency situations with a series of presentations in schools and city halls, on emergency interventions,
- Editing and distributing informative materials, flyers.
- Elaboration of a joint "Best practice manual" containing the experiences of project implementation that could also be used by other organizations and institutions acting in the field of risk prevention and disaster management.
- Elaboration of a documentary film with project activities and results
- Organization of a joint workshop on the topic "Civil protection: the ecological accident: manifestation, effects and methods of intervention, warning and evacuation of population" in Halmeu.
- Organization of a joint workshop on "Performance criteria related to the creation and equipping of voluntary services" in Odoreu.
- Organizing joint workshop and exchange of experience on "Activities of the Local Committee for Emergency Situations" in Paulesti.
- Organizing a joint workshop on "Psychological support of population" (emergency situations, road accidents in cross-border context), with the participation of experts of the Police and General Directorate for Emergency Situations.
- Organizing a press conference, followed by the joint workshop: "Efficient solutions for emergency situations in the cross-border area" with the participation of VSES, ISU and invited experts/lecturers, authorities etc. A "COOPERATION PROTOCOL" between the partner organizations from the cross-border area, for the continuation of partnership and collaboration after the project closure was signed

The Programme Output Indicator is 5/b1 "Population safeguarded by improved emergency response services". Through the project ROHU-80, 75,160 peoples are better safeguarded by improved emergency response services.







The project ROHU-80 has improved the infrastructure of the institutions involved in emergency response activities from Satu Mare and Szabolcs-Szatmár-Bereg Counties and the volunteer firefighters abilities by purchasing reliable, high-quality equipment and through joint training, workshops and practices for firefighters. Also, the increased quality of joint risk management in the cross-border area, the higher quality services and better safeguard of the population are important as project results.
