Summary	<p>The ROHU-84 project aims to improve cross-border disaster resilience capacity by developing a joint risk management strategy; increasing the quality of cross-border interventions in risk situations; developing the skills of professional and voluntary intervention staff to address different types of emergencies, to establish additional joint operations in the event of disasters.</p> <p>The main activities are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • BP: the creation of the Regional Cross-border Training Center for integrated emergency preparedness training in Sântion, Borş (RO) by renovating and modernizing an existing training centre • Purchasing equipment for training (2 containers for preparedness and training for rescuers and 1 container which will serve as a locker, storage and shower room)

<p>Main results</p>	<p>The main result of the project is the increasing joint capacity to prevent risks and emergency management. This was possible after the extension, modernization and jointly operated two regional centres for cross-border training and integrated emergency preparedness located in Borş and Hajdúszoboszló, the new Cross-border strategy for risk prevention and disaster management in the Bihor-Hajdú Bihar Euroregion and the joint training programs for volunteer staff and professional firefighters involved in risk and disaster management from this Euroregion.</p>
