<b>Objective</b>	The main objective of the project is to build cooperation and strengthen the relationships in the cross-border area of Oradea (RO) and Zsombó (HU), by creating a cross border climbing league and organizing climbing events, in the context of small-case cooperation initiatives in the field of sports.

<b>Summary</b>	<p>The project ROHU-122 aims to increase the number of sport lovers who practice climbing and to create a beneficial atmosphere by attracting sports people from the frontier region. The approach is new and goes beyond the existing practice in the programme area.</p> <p>The main activities of the project are the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• establishing of new cross-border climbing methods based on cooperation of institutions and communities (wall climbing will be promoted in schools of the Romanian-Hungarian frontier region);</li> <li>• organizing cross border climbing camp, for children with special needs from both sides of the Romanian-Hungarian area;</li> <li>• creating innovative climbing infrastructure;</li> </ul>

Project ROHU – 122 contributes to this indicator by reaching a number of 138 people from Romania and Hungary, participating in the activities of cross border climbing.</p> <p>The collaboration of the partners within this project leads to an improvement of cooperation between civil organizations and between people in the cross-border area, through sport, by attracting sports people, children and students who have never encountered climbing as a sport.</p>
<b>Main results</b>	<p>The project's main results are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- setting up <b>a cross-border climbing league</b></li> <li>- establishing a system of basic <b>rules for organizing competitions</b></li> <li>- <b>8 cross-border climbing events</b> and cross-cultural nights organized in RO and HU</li> <li>- organizing <b>open climbing days in schools</b> in Romania and Hungary</li> <li>- <b>2 cross-border climbing camps</b>, in Hungary and Romania, <b>for children with special needs</b></li> <li>- <b>2 sessions of therapy through movement</b> for children with special needs in Romania and Hungary</li> <li>- <b>138 people</b> participating in cross-border cooperation initiatives.</li> </ul>
