Summary	The project ROHU-156 aims to organise a series of 8 cross-border cultural events in order to promote the cultural cooperation between the communities of Pecica (RO) and Mórahalom (HU). The project enables event participants to prepare and taste traditional dishes, to perform folk dances and to participate in traditional agricultural activities in the two cities. The main activities of the project are: organizing 6 events related to spring, summer and winter traditions in both localities; organizing 2 events dedicated to cultural traditions from both localities and exhibition of art creations by contemporary artists;







	 editing 2 publications about local traditions in Pecica and Mórahalom; establishing of a collection consisting in photo/ video presentations of traditions from both sides of the border; acquisition on behalf of both partners of traditional outfits for popular dances for men and women and traditional dishes, to be used in the cultural events, as well as the preparation and presentation of traditional dishes.
	The Programme Output Indicator is "11/b2 Number of people directly involved in cross-border cooperation initiatives". Project ROHU–156 contributes to this indictor by reaching a number of 1,450 people participants in the activities of the project, for the promotion of the local traditions.
	The collaboration of the partners within this project gives them the opportunity to learn more about each other's traditions and create a new form of cultural cooperation between contemporary artists from Pecica (RO) and Mórahalom (HU), which have the opportunity to jointly organize annual exhibitions in both cities.
Main results	The project's main results are: 8 cultural events organized in both localities, with the direct involvement of 1450 people, that include: preparation of local dishes from Pecica and Morahalom, folk dances and music, presentation of traditional objects, activities or topographies and local peculiarities related to the season; creation of a wide range of promotional material, including: publications, press releases, posters, that will be used for disseminating the project results.
