	<ul> <li>organizing in Romania and Hungary of dedicated camps for young people, in order to create opportunities, to gain new experiences, to develop self-knowledge about contemporary drug consumption;</li> <li>establishing dedicated clubs in Romania and Hungary and organizing events, where young people can express themselves</li> </ul>
