Project ROHU-202 contributes to this indicator by reaching a number of 104 young people from the two communities situated on the shores of Mures River, participants in the cultural events.</p> <p>The collaboration of the partners within this project raises awareness of the existence of common elements in the structure of the local identities of the 8 communities living on both sides of the border on the bank of the Mureş river, thus strengthening their sense of belonging to their own locality and generating a common regional identity.</p>
