The main activities of the project are: organizing 4 events of crafts and folk arts focused on local products, thus significantly contributing to the preservation and promotion of traditional products, of the related production methods and of various tools and equipment used implementing a series of coordination initiatives for the promotion, improvement and joint development of local events,
