Objective	The project aims to improve prevention and health care services in the obstetrics-gynaecology and neonatology field in the Hungarian-Romanian cross-border area through a strategic approach, by investing in medical infrastructure, including equipment, and implementing soft measures resulting from collaboration and the know-how exchange, in order to reduce health inequalities among the population.

Summary	<p>Common territorial challenges on the Romanian-Hungarian cross-border are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • reduced health care spendings (under Eu average 8,5%) in both countries, • obsolete medical equipment, old and improper buildings, • lack of interconnected emergency response service, • discrepancies between the quality of health-care services from Hungary and Romania, resulting in health-care migration. <p>Project main activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • LB, PP3: construction works and endowment with medical equipment for the Emergency Clinical County Hospital "Pius Brinzeu" in Timișoara • PP2: reconstruction and endowment of the Department of Obstetrics-Gynecology and installation of electronic patient records system for intensive care of the Pediatric Clinic of the University of Szeged • LB, PP2, PP3: procurement and installation of new medical equipment and furniture.

<p>Summary</p>	<p>The partners will also contribute to developing soft elements of the project:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • exchanges of experiences (know-how) through specialized medical conferences (videoconferences and workshops) • harmonization of the therapeutic guidances and recommendations from RO and HU in the obstetrics-gynaecology and neonatology field, in order to develop the common cooperation framework • awareness campaigns for the rural population from communities in Timiș County and professional meetings in Szeged • promotion and publicity. <p>The Programme Output Indicators are „9/a 1 Population having access to improved health services” and „9/a 2 Number of health-care departments affected by modernized equipment”. Through ROHU-443 project, 1,976,348 persons will benefit from improved health care services and 15 health-care units will be built/renovated/modernized and endowed with new equipment.</p>
<p>Main outputs</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • LB, PP3: improved health-care infrastructure for the Emergency County Clinic Hospital in Timișoara, by the newly built Obstetrics-Gynecology Clinic, located on a 5000 sqm site near the Emergency County Clinic Hospital, with 6 floors and 126 beds for patients and 13 medical departments equipped and furnished (more than 200 pieces of high-performance medical equipment and more than 2400 pieces of furniture/equipment), thus improved quality of the medical services. Total value of the investment: 12.06 million euros. • PP2: improved health-care infrastructure for Department of Obstetrics-Gynecology and Pediatric Clinic of the University of Szeged, by one operating theatre of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology rehabilitated and 2 medical departments equipped with 75 pieces of modernized equipment.
