Summary	The project ROHU-316 organizes different cultural activities for young and adult people, in order to help the population of the three localities to know better each other's local heritage and to raise the social cohesion in the border region.  The main activities of the project are:  - organizing cultural, gastronomic and religious events in the three localities:  • a folks dance camp for children in Jimbolia  • a one-day gastronomy festival with 6 participating teams in Carpinis  • 2 church festivals with 30 guests/festival in Carpinis  • a 6-day children camp and a 1-day children festival in Csanadpalota

Main results	- 3 events dedicated to children, out of which: 1 folk dance camp,
	organized by the Lead Beneficiary in Jimbolia (RO), where
	participants learned folk dances and folk music, pottery,
	manufacture of leather objects, wood, embroidery, beads and
	wool and 1 youth camps and a children festival, organized in
	Csanádpalota (HU) by Project Partner no. 3, including different
	activities, like sports, leisure and culture.
	- 3 gastronomic events, 1 in Cărpiniș (RO) and 2 in Csanádpalota
	(HU), which consisted in preparing traditional dishes from the
	region and keeping an old tradition of the Hungarian Partner,
	called <i>"Böllérnap"</i> . This is an old, traditional event, held every
	winter in Csanádpalota and consists in preparation of different
	types of pork sausages.
	- 2 religious events were organized in Cărpiniș, offering religious
	music and ceremonies to the people attending those events
	- 2 cultural events, one in Jimbolia and one in Csanádpalota,
	where, along with the cultural activities, a dissemination of the
	results of the project and an exchange of experience and good
	practice between participants has been carried out.
