Summary	<p>The project aims to increase the tourist attraction capacity of the cross-border area of Hortobágy and Sălacea, seen as an integrated tourism destination, due to the increased number of natural sites worth visiting.</p> <p>Main activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Creating a new cross-border thematic route that connects two bridges and addresses both families with children and young couples in search of adventure in nature • Promoting the new cross-border thematic route by creating 3000 brochures with map included, 1000 albums and a documentary film presenting Hortobágy and Sălacea regions • Organizing events for promoting the cross-border thematic route (2 cross-border nature protection volunteer camps, 4 travelling photo exhibition events presenting Hortobágy and Salacea regions) • Promoting the didactic route on Hortobágy River, as a key element of the cross-border thematic route (1000 booklet presenting the didactic route and mobile friendly webpage)

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Conserving and improving the Salacea pasture by forming an ecological corridor especially for amphibians and insects (1 study concerning amphibians and vegetation groups, 2 information panels presenting the species, 1 ecological corridor connecting the two sides of Salacea Pasture and 1 evaluation document) • Creating a natural heritage based visitor infrastructure in the neighbourhood of Salacea Pasture (a new building hosting the tourist reception and information area, a parking lot, a pedestrian alley network, an environmental education area for children, a thematic and education track system, an observatory and a resting place for tourists) • Constructing a bike track and rehabilitating the brick bridge • Developing the light pollution-free, public illumination of Hortobágy Village • Developing 1 evaluation study supporting the establishment of a protected area of local importance, 1 nature conservation management plan <p>The Programme Output Indicator are CO09 <i>Sustainable Tourism: Increase in expected number of visits to supported sites of cultural and natural heritage and attractions</i> and CO23 <i>Nature and biodiversity: Surface area of habitats supported to attain a better conservation status</i>. Through the project ROHU-115, the expected number of visits to supported sites of cultural and natural heritage and attractions increased with 5000 and 968 ha of land, has a better conservation status.</p>
<p>Main results</p>	<p>The project results are related to the two new cross-border thematic routes created in Sălacea and Hortobágy region. The touristic area upgraded with a building hosting the tourist reception and information area, a parking lot, a pedestrian alley, a bike track and a new public illumination. All this investment have as a result the increased number of tourists in the area.</p>
