<b>Summary</b>	<p>Project ROHU-357 aims to eliminate bottlenecks in health-care activity by purchasing and installing modern medical equipment, preventing and diagnosing diseases with high frequency in the eligible area, with special attention to disadvantaged groups by strengthening the project partners institutional capacity.</p> <p>The main activities are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Purchasing and installation the equipment for automatization of the Medical Analysis Laboratory of the County Clinical Emergency Hospital Oradea with impact on 31 medical departments</li> <li>• Purchasing and installation of the necessary equipment for 4 medical departments from Grof Tisza Istvan Hospital located in Berettyóújfalu (Laboratory, Emergency Unit, Gynecology and Pharmacy)</li> <li>• Purchasing and installation of necessary medical equipment for 3 medical departments located in Hajduboszormeny City</li> </ul>

	<p>(Rehabilitation treatments - cardiology and musculoskeletal, Medical Spa and Primary Dental care);</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Organizing promotional actions for health screening and providing information to prevent and diagnose diseases with high frequency in the eligible area, both in Oradea ,Berettyóújfalú and Hajduboszormeny City. At least 2,500 patients from targeted area, will benefit annually from disease prevention and early diagnose due to the interactive, information available on partners' websites;</li> <li>Improving access to health infrastructure for disadvantaged groups. At least 1,100 people from disadvantaged groups in both countries will be informed regarding the health-care services they could benefit from.</li> <li>Through the know-how exchange and capacity building activities. 60 physicians and medical assistants from GTIK (PP2) and Hajdúböszörmény (PP3) participate to study visits at SCJUO (LP) and 9 medical staff representing all partners from the project will also participate in international medical conferences.</li> </ul> <p>The Programme Output Indicators are „9/a 1 Population having access to improved health services” and „9/a 2 Number of health-care departments affected by modernized equipment”. Through project ROHU – 357, a number of 711,343 persons benefit from improved health care services and 38 health-care departments are more efficient, using modernized equipment purchased through the project.</p>
<p><b>Main results</b></p>	<p>Through the project ROHU–357, a total of 38 health-care departments are benefiting from modern equipment, enhancing the access of the population from both sides of the border to improved medical services. As a result, patients are having access to an appropriate level of healthcare services across the two neighbouring counties, regardless of their social status, financial situation or residence.</p> <p>As a result of experience's exchanges and participation in international medical events, the medical staff of these 3 hospitals has improved their competencies.</p>
