Summary	 The project ROHU-391 aims to enhance the mobility of the workforce between the two counties by increasing the logistic capacity, establishing logistic and training centres and improve the co-operation between unemployed people and other labour market actors to support raising employment rates in the cross-border region. The main activities are: Building 1 logistics center in Ajak by renovating and equipping an existing warehouse and including a training center Building 1 new logistics center in Halmeu, including a vegetable and fruit refrigeration hall and including a training center. Elaboration of a joint survey with the aim of exploring and assessing the needs of local job seekers, employers, the qualification of the existing workforce in Ajak and Halmeu Organising a number of 8 information lectures and workshops in Ajak;
