Summary	<p>The main objective of the ROHU-374 project is to increase the transnational mobility of the labour force through the planned activities. Also, it aims to improve cross-border access to the labour market, increasing employment opportunities for people from both sides of the border and thus contributing to advancing inclusion in the cross-border area.</p> <p>The main activities planned to be implemented are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Organizing 2 trainings in Timiș county: Social and civic competences training for 150 young people (15–25-year-old) divided into 10 groups, with 15 people/group and Entrepreneurial basic knowledge

	<p>training for 80 persons (16–65-year-old) divided into 4 groups, 20 persons/group;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Organizing 2 trainings in Csongr�ad-Csan�ad County: Cross-border career orientation and planning training for 120 young people (15–25-year-old) and Entrepreneurial basic knowledge training for 80 persons (16–65-year-old) • Elaboration of the training materials and obtaining the accreditation of these courses. • Construction/rehabilitation of the Training Centre in Zolt, including the necessary equipment for the training centre; • Construction of the Training Centre in Domaszek (two-floor building, with training rooms and accommodation rooms for trainees), including the necessary equipment for the training centre. <p>The Programme Output Indicator is „CO44 Labour Market and Training: Number of participants in joint local employment initiatives and joint training”. Through project ROHU–374, 430 persons benefit from trainings/ specializations that will help them successfully enter the labour market.</p>
