# CONTEXT





December 31st, 2023 -ROHU Programme end date

60 (out of 100) selected projects finalized

ERDF funding has become available

to be used transparently and efficiently

for the best Programme performances

- ✓ Scope: set the general methodology for using any available ERDF, until the end of the Programme implementation;
- ✓ Available ERDF as of September 2022 *Annex 1. ROHU ERDF* (living table).







### THE PROCEDURAL AND LEGAL FRAMEWORK

- **Memorandum of Implementation (MoI)** up to 110% funds over-contracted;
- **Methodology for over-contracting -** special measures to be implemented:

#### STEP 1

Available ERDF - prevalently used to cover over-contracted projects under each Ip/PA, in the ranking order

#### STEP 2

If still available ERDF - reallocations to cover over-contracted projects under other Ips/PAs (CP modification, if the case)







## THE PROCEDURAL AND LEGAL FRAMEWORK

- **❖ REGULATION (EU) 2020/460** up to **8** % of a PA allocation and no more than **4** % of the CP budget may be transfered to another PA/Ip − without Programme modification;
- The eligibility rules set maximum ceilings for ERDF funding unused/saved ERDF provided to projects under implementation up to the ceilings (Annex 1\_ROHU ERDF):

## **METHOD**

- Procedural framework
- Timeframe until the end of the programming period

Additional funding is to be provided only to projects currently under implementation

Projects will submit (until a set deadline) requests for additional funding, targeting:

- 1. increased costs for activities implemented or being implemented in the context of their projects (e.g. costs are higher, may have increased and/or have not been covered by the approved project budget, etc.);
- 2. costs related to additional activities, to be further implemented, complementary to the project work plan and directly contributing to the project goal/objectives/results/indicators.







## **DECISION & STEPS OF THE PROCESS**

Monitoring Committee will decide upon the best funding scenario, considering:

- ✓ transparency and equal treatment, making sure all interested parties have access to the public funding;
- ✓ **Programme's overall performance**, specifically the output and results indicators and the absorption rate.

JS calls projects to submit Additional funding requests
