Summary	The project ROHU-156 organised 8 cross-border cultural events to promote cultural cooperation between Pecica (RO) and Mórahalom (HU) communities. Thus, traditional dishes were prepared and tasted, folk dances were performed, and traditional agricultural activities took place in the two cities. The main activities implemented within the project::

- 1 event presenting summer traditions within a local event
 "Celebration of the New Bread" in Pecica;
- 2 events presenting winter traditions, related to Saint Lucy's
 Day in Morahalom and "Ignat Preparation of traditional
 dishes at the slaughtering of pigs", "Exhibition of decorations
 for Christmas", "Live" Bethlehem" and "Presentation of
 traditional Christmas desserts" in Pecica,
- 1 event related to cultural traditions and the creations of contemporary artists in Pecica;
- 1 event related to autumn traditions during the traditional event Grape Harvest celebration in Morahalom
- 1 event presenting the contemporaries artists from Morahalom and Pecica and their art;
- 1 event related to summer traditions during the traditional event Grain Harvest celebration in Morahalom;
- Publishing a book and a bilingual calendar about the local traditions of Pecica and Mórahalom (in 300 copies each);
- Creating a collection consisting of photo/video presentations of the traditions of the 2 localities;
- Purchasing traditional folk dance outfits for men and women for cultural events (12 Romanian and 12 Hungarian dance costumes).
- Purchasing materials for events (tablecloths, tableware, cutlery, small and large glasses, coffee sets)

On October 31, 2020, the project was successfully finalized.
All activities provided in the project were completed (100%)

The Programme Output Indicator is "11/b2 Number of people directly involved in cross-border cooperation initiatives". Through project ROHU–156 activities, **1,492 people** participated in the promotion of local traditions.

The partners' collaboration allowed them to learn more about their traditions and created a new form of cultural cooperation between contemporary artists from Pecica (RO) and Mórahalom (HU), which had the opportunity to organize jointly annual exhibitions in both cities.
