





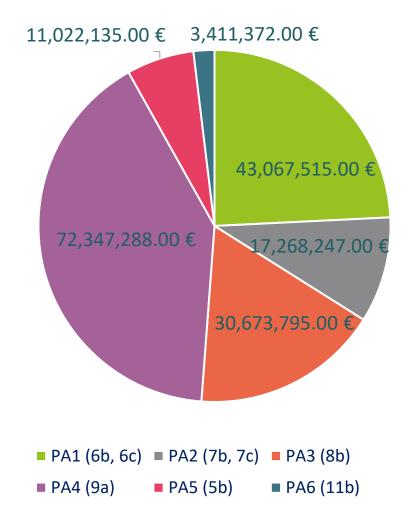

- The modernization of 2 wastewater treatment plants **completed**;
- The canal bed of Cigányka-ér channel and its water transport capability \( \sqrt{restored} \);
- 2 pumping stations and 1 monitoring station on the Cigányka-ér channel built;

#### Joint Protection and Efficient Use of Common Values and Resources

- 14 projects contracted:
  - 3 strategic projects, under implementation;
  - 11 normal projects: 4 under implementation, 7 completed.

- 42 partners (24 RO + 18 HU)
- 40,324,578.29 € total ERDF









**Achievements:** 

• 77,267 visits to supported sites of cultural and natural heritage and attractions counted;

- 26,049 hectares of habitats **\$\frac{1}{20}\$ supported** to attain a better conservation status;
- Over 50 investments in visitor infrastructure and cultural facilities completed;
- Over 100 events on environmental awareness and nature conservation organ

- 12.14 km of *new* roads *built*, and over 20 km *modernized*;
- 12 cross-border public transport services *developed* or improved;
- Over 20 km of new bicycle tracks completed;



#### Improve employment and promote cross-border labor mobility

- 19 projects contracted:
  - 1 strategic project, under implementation;
  - 18 normal projects, 14 under implementation, 4 completed.

- 60 partners (34 RO + 26 HU)
- 30,669,678.80 € total ERDF







- 2 new training centers are prepared and equipped, while 26 are undergoing construction works;
- Over 200 training courses were organized, while others are still ongoing;
- More than 16,000 people participated in joint training, in joint local employment initiatives.



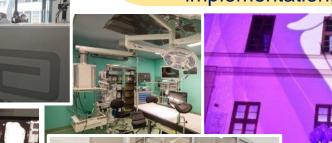
## Improving healthcare services



Ip 9a

- 16 projects contracted:
  - strategic projects, under implementation;
  - 12 normal projects, 6 under implementation, 6 completed.

- 40 partners (24 RO + 16 HU)
- 65,425,780.42 € total ERDF











**Achievements:** 

- 1 hospital \*\* extended and modernized, 1 new hospital under construction;
- 6 emergency healthcare units \*\* established;
- More than 175 medical departments *equipped* with state-of-the-art medical equipment and technology;
- Approx. 4 mil. people in the cross-border area benefit from improved health care services.





### Improve risk-prevention and disaster management



lp 5b

• 10 normal projects contracted: 2 under implementation, 8 completed.

- 28 partners (17 RO + 11 HU)
- 11,833,716.00 € total ERDF













#### Achievements:

- 5 investments in disaster management infrastructure completed;
- More than 20 pieces of *intervention vehicles* and *equipment* purchased;
- Training courses and events related to disaster management and risk prevention organized;
- Over 1.4 million people from the cross-border area are safeguarded by improved emergency response services.

#### Promoting Cross-border Cooperation Between Institutions And Citizens

33 normal projects contracted: 2 under implementation, 31 completed.

- 88 partners (51 RO + 37 HU)
- 3,788,688.22 € total ERDF



- More than 150 cross-border events organized;
- 38 *institutions* directly involved in cross border cooperation initiatives;
- More than 28,000 people participated in *cross-border cooperation initiatives*.

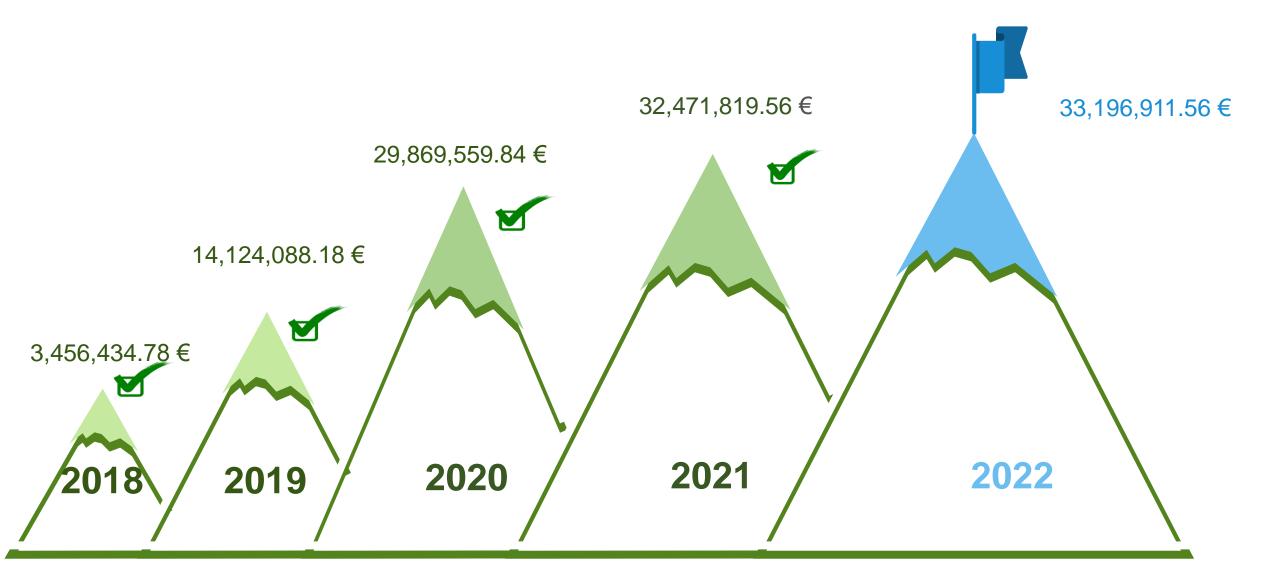

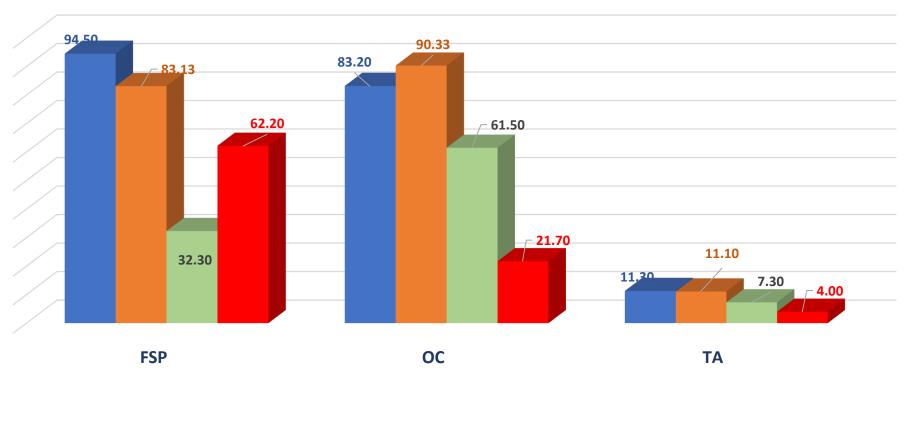

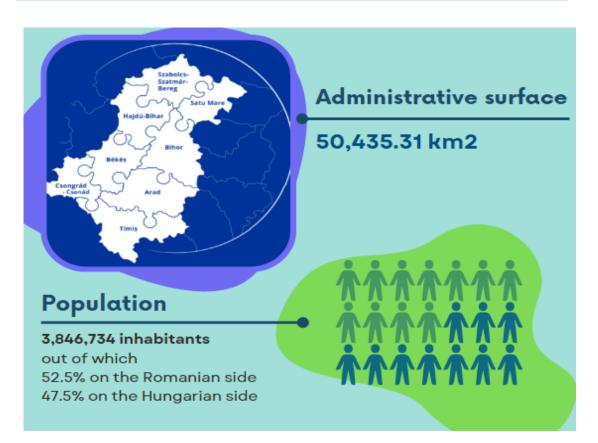
Interreg VI-A Romania-Hungary Programme
