There will certainly be several complementarities and synergies with EC programmes under EC direct management, as indicated in the following table. However, due to the differences related to the scale, territorial coverage and objectives of these programmes, the scope of the actions and expected results will possibly be synergic and complementary, whilst never overlapping. On the other hand, as far as the Recovery and Resilience Facility is concerned, there will also be strong complementarities and synergies with all selected priority objectives. However, the RRF will be focused on the impact of funds on structural reforms' processes at national level, whilst Interreg actions will be focused on the attainment of cross-border cooperation objectives.

• Complementarities and synergies with other Interreg programmes 2021-2027

Few Interreg programmes will cover the same Romania-Hungary programme area on both sides of the border in the same time. These are: Interreg Europe, Interreg Danube and Interreg Hungary-Slovakia-Romania-Ukraine. Although there could be strong synergies (ex. valorisation of lessons leant, results, replication of best practices, fructification of existing partnerships), the scale, territorial coverage and objectives of these programmes will avoid the occurrence of the risk of double

funding. As concerns other Interreg programmes, involving at least one of the MS (Hungary or Romania), although many programmes have selected the same priorities and policy objectives, the territorial coverage of the interventions will be different from the Interreg ROHU programme (in most cases, other border areas will be targeted).
