	Project ROHU-388 aims to enhance the cooperation of local labour market actors in order to improve labour matching and the employment situation, increase the institutional capacity of all the involved partners and create a long-term context for dialogue and cooperation regarding the educational & training level of the inhabitants of the involved communities.
Summary	 The main activities are: Developing a strategic document regarding the Oradea Metropolitan area's labour market. Acquisition of the equipment by all partners to properly implement the activities from the project; Developing two strategic documents: the Békés County strategy regarding the labour market and a collection of best entrepreneurial practices. Organizing five workshops and working sessions for around 300 persons that will benefit from mentoring expertise and experience as well as from vocational counselling services.





	 Organizing training courses. A particular group of activities will take place, involving all partners in the training process by providing training courses to 300 participants, preparing the examination process, and finalizing the training courses/groups with the exam sessions. Renovating and endowing the CDDL building, where the activities will take place.
	The Programme Output Indicator is <i>"CO44 Labour Market and Training:</i> <i>Number of participants in joint local employment initiatives and joint training".</i> Through project ROHU – 388, 600 persons benefit from the supported joint employment initiatives and training. 300 persons graduate from certified training courses, in 2 disciplines, entrepreneurial skills and IT competencies and 300 people are attending specifically dedicated workshops with mentors in entrepreneurial best practices, instruments and tools.
Main results	Through the project ROHU–388, employment opportunities in the rural area are increasing. 600 persons increase their employment potential after graduating from certified training courses, in 2 disciplines, entrepreneurial skills and IT competencies. Also, they are attending specifically dedicated workshops with mentors in entrepreneurial best practices and instruments. Moreover, a sustainable development centre is established and well-equipped in the rural area of Oradea Metropolitan Area, namely in Les Village and, Nojorid Commune.
