Objective	The main objective was to increase the quality of health services in Moftin and Nyíradony and their surroundings with a complex infrastructure investment and special equipment purchasing, which contributes to the establishment of adequate community health services in the border area.

Summary	Project ROHU-392 aimed to improve the quality of health infrastructure in Moftin and developing an emergency health service in Nyíradony by building an Ambulance Station. Through this partnership the cross-border relations among public health care institutions and partners are strengthed.
	 The main activities were: Modernizing a total of 8 medical departments: in Moftin, 6 health care departments: 3 family medicine departments (1 in Moftinu Mic, 1 in Moftinu Mare, 1 in Domăneşti), 1 functional explorations department, 1 laboratory medicine department, 1







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	stomatology department. In Nyradony 1 emergency medicine department; specialized medical transportation service; • Development of a rural healthcare network (formed of 3 rural healthcare centers in 3 of the largest villages of the Moftin commune) and of the Ambulance Service in Nyradoni; • Acquisition of medical equipment • 12 events regarding health care measures for the population (6 health prevention meetings in Moftin and 6 health days in Nyíradony) • Organizing 3 screening actions, 2 cross border workshops on prevention and 1 first aid training event in Moftin • 1 Rural Health Care Network Web Page containing information on how to prevent several illnesses, advices for healthy life behaviour etc.
	The Programme Output Indicators are "9/a 1 Population having access to improved health services" and "9/a 2 Number of health-care departments affected by modernized equipment". Through project ROHU – 392, a number of 54,828 persons are benefiting from improved health care services and 7 health-care departments are more efficient using modernized equipment purchased through the project.
Main results	Through the project ROHU – 392, a total number of 16 localities from Romania and Hungary benefited from the newly built health infrastructure in Moftin with new health equipment and the new health service created in Nyíradony. The direct beneficiaries who can use the modernized health services were the more than 54.000 citizens from the project area. The following medical branches were positively affected: family medicine (developing a Rural Healthcare Network in Moftin); functional explorations; laboratory medicine; stomatology; emergency medicine; specialized medical transportation service.
