Objective	The project's main objective was to harmonize the drug prevention programs on both sides of the border. Also, to present these programs to each partner to initiate exchanges of experience and translate this knowledge into practice to reduce drug use in the region.

Summary	The project aimed to involve young people at risk of social exclusion in multicultural activities and to strengthen the international dimension of youth activities. Also, supporting and consolidating the role of workers and drug prevention organizations as support structures for young people is followed. The main activities implemented within the project: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> organizing training sessions for the team members of both project partners, regarding common problems faced by adolescents and young people;



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> organizing in Romania and Hungary dedicated camps for young people, in order to create opportunities, gain new experiences, to develop self-knowledge about contemporary drug consumption; establishing dedicated clubs in Romania and Hungary and organizing events, where young people can express themselves through performing arts, practising sports and participating in debates; organizing on behalf of the Lead Beneficiary in Hungary a drug-related exhibition, covering all stages of drug addiction. <p><i>On February 29, 2020, the project was successfully finalized. All activities provided in the project were completed (100%).</i></p> <p>The Programme Output Indicator is „11/b2 Number of people directly involved in cross-border cooperation initiatives”. In project ROHU-180 activities 1725 people participated in drug prevention-raising awareness campaigns and events.</p>
