Summary	The project ROHU-200 aimed to establish an informal frame and an active interaction between the inhabitants of the four localities and to increase their awareness regarding their specific customs and traditions through participation and involvement in concerts and traditional cooking contests.
	The main activities implemented within the project:







	 organizing 4 cooking contests, 1 by each partner, within the traditional festivals that take place each year: Cabbage Festival in Toboliu (RO) and Körösnagyharsány (HU), Village Days in Girisu de Cris (RO) and Autumn Fest in Nojorid (RO), with the participation of contestants from Romania and Hungary. At the cooking contests there will be prepared traditional cabbage dishes, served for free to all the participants and guests; organizing 4 concerts within the yearly organized festivals, in each commune, with the participation of Romanian and Hungarian artists and bands; purchasing equipment to be used for events: a mobile scene including a sound and lights system, 8 wooden kiosks for displaying traditional products and 3 cooking boilers with stoves and disposable tableware. The partners' collaboration within this project led to a strengthened relationship between the four communities and their inhabitants and a population more aware of the cultural traditions.
	On November 30, 2019, the project was successfully finalized. All activities provided in the project were completed (100%).
	The Programme Output Indicator is "11/b2 Number of people participating in cross-border cooperation initiatives". Through project activities, 513 people have participated in joint cultural events.
	The project's main results are: -1 cooking contest and 1 concert at the Cabbage Festival in Toboliu with 184 participants
