	On January 31, 2020, the project was successfully finalized. All activities provided in the project were completed (100%).
	The Programme Output Indicator is "11/b2 Number of people participating in cross-border cooperation initiatives". In project ROHU–218, 622 participants took part in the following activities:
	1. Traditional school gardens – 180 participants (Excelsior 109 people, PP 71 persons)
	2."Seeds collection expedition" and "Seeds Exchange Fair"- events organized in Romania – 327 people
	3. "Seeds collection expedition" and "Seeds Exchange Fair" events organized in Hungary – 115 people.
	The collaboration of the partners within this project involved the local communities, mainly children and students, in activities of preserving and promoting traditional gardening, as part of the local cultural traditional heritage and as a factor for landscape biodiversity conservation.
Main results	 The project's main results are: 622 people participating in cross-border cooperation initiatives "Demonstrative traditional garden" in Semlac, realized The "traditional school gardens" – 180 people participated in

maintaining the traditional school gardens







- The "Expedition for seed collection" 200 pupils and teachers, together with 20 volunteers and staff members participated from Romania and Hungary
- The "Seed Exchange Fairs" organized in Arad and Gyula for more than 250 peoples
