| <p><b>Main results</b></p> | <p>The project's main results are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>2025 people</b> participated in cross border cultural events</li> <li>- <b>musical youth camp</b> and concerts organized by the LB with the help of a team consisting of 50 people (from both Hungary and Romania).</li> <li>- A <b>7-day-long Musical Youth Camp</b> in Nyírbátor with the participation of volunteers from Nyírbátor and Cheț.</li> <li>- The <b>CrossYounity concert tour</b>, with the participation of volunteers from Nyírbátor and Cheț. The tour consisted <b>in 8 concerts</b> on both sides of the border, 4 concerts were organized in Hungary and 4 were organized in Romania</li> <li>- <b>4 workshops</b> have been organized with/for the volunteers in Nyírbátor</li> <li>- <b>outdoor activities</b> (5 days long) organized in Nyírbátor set participants to face challenges and do trust exercises that helped them think creatively and collaborate with one another</li> </ul>  |
