Summary	The project ROHU-265 organized a series of multi-annual events through which cultural diversity and local traditions are promoted. The main activities implemented within the project: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> organizing two cultural events in Cetariu, (RO), through which will be presented folk ensembles and sportive competitions for young people; organizing three cultural events in Kaba (HU), which have a rich heritage value;



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • acquisition by the Lead Beneficiary of specific pieces of equipment used for organizing cultural events: mobile scene and sound system, • acquisition by Project Partner 2 of a specific illumination system, that will be used for winter events. <p><i>On April 30, 2020, the project was successfully finalized.</i> <i>All activities provided in the project were completed (100%).</i></p> <p>The Programme Output Indicator is „11/b2 Number of people participating in cross-border cooperation initiatives“. Through project ROHU – 265, 825 people participated in the project’s cultural events.</p> <p>The collaboration of the partners within this project raised the citizens’ awareness regarding the specific traditions of both localities and created a framework in which people gather and are able to exchange their cultural values.</p>
<p>Main results</p>	<p>The project’s main results are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 5 large cultural events, organized not only for the local communities but for the entire cross-border area : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New Bread Feast-Kaba- August 17, 2019 • Summer events-Cetariu-August 3 & 4, 2019 • Grapes Festival-Cetariu-September 7, 2019 • Advent event Kaba-December 22, 2019 • Carnival Kaba-February 15, 2020 - specific equipment purchased to help the municipalities to ensure the continuous character of these events (Cetariu purchased a mobile scene, 10 sets of tables & wooden benches and a sound system and Kaba purchased and installed a set of equipment and services for illumination).
