Summary	Project ROHU-401 aimed to improve the healthcare services across the three counties by purchasing and installing modern medical equipment and also by preventing and diagnosing diseases with high frequency in the eligible area, with special attention to disadvantaged groups. The main activities implemented within the project: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Purchasing and equipping 3 healthcare departments within the Institute of Cardiovascular Diseases Timișoara (2 Cardiovascular Surgery rooms, Cardiology and Sterilization), • Purchasing and equipping 2 healthcare departments (Gynecological Surgery and Intensive Care) and 10 rooms for patients within County Emergency Clinical Hospital in Oradea

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Purchasing and equipping 2 healthcare departments (Obstetrics–Gynecology, Cardiology and cardiac surgery) within the University of Debrecen • Organizing campaigns for health screening and prevention activities for 700 patients, to prevent and diagnose diseases with high frequency in the eligible area; • Organizing a campaign consisting of free consultations offered to 200 persons with low incomes and from disadvantaged groups, to improve their access to health infrastructure • Organizing Know-how exchange and capacity-building activities (online training courses and workshops) between project partners for 80 physicians and medical assistants <p><i>On July 31, 2021, the project was successfully finalized. All activities provided in the project were completed (100%).</i></p> <p>The Programme Output Indicators are „9/a 1 Population having access to improved health services” and „9/a 2 Number of healthcare departments affected by modernized equipment”. Through project ROHU-401, a number of 1,600,391 people (759,819 population of Timis County, 314,408 feminine population of Bihor County and 526,164 population of Hajdu-Bihar County in 2021) benefited from improved healthcare services and 7 healthcare departments are more efficient using modernized equipment purchased through the project.</p>
<p>Main results</p>	<p>The main results of the project are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1,600,391 people benefited from improved healthcare services and 7 healthcare departments are more efficient using modernized equipment purchased through the project for the Institute of Cardiovascular Diseases Timisoara, Oradea County Emergency Clinical Hospital and the University of Debrecen • health screening promoted and provided information for the prevention and diagnosis of high-frequency diseases in the eligible area; • 255 persons from disadvantaged groups have improved access to health infrastructure (LP - 155 pers, PP2 - 100 pers); • institutional capacity of the partners improved through know-how exchange and capacity-building activities (training courses and conferences) between project partners, as follows: 40 different physicians and medical assistants of PP2 participated in the 5 workshops and trainings organized by PP3 and 56 persons of LP's medical staff participated to the online workshop and live-case demonstration organized by PP3 University of Debrecen on the 28th of May 2021.
