Summary	The project ROHU-202 aimed at creating a framework of cross-border collaboration between the 8 communities situated on both shores of the Mures River: Igris, Cenad, Pecica, Semlac (RO) and Deszk, Magyarcsanak, Maroslele, Ferencszallas (HU), by involving young people and adults from these communities into working together and achieving joint goals. The main activities implemented within the project: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Establishing local clubs of young people in the 8 Romanian and Hungarian localities: Igris, Cenad, Pecica, Semlac, Deszk, Magyarcsanak, Maroslele, Ferencszallas;

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> organizing joint cultural events: a workshop for club leaders, a thematic bilingual workbook about Mures, 2 picnics with the involvement of target groups of both sides of the border, preparing a film, as a virtual exposition, where each of the involved 8 localities gets the opportunity to present their activities and elaborated works. <p><i>On October 31, 2021, the project was successfully finalized. All activities provided in the project were completed (100%).</i></p> <p>Programme Output Indicator is „11/b2 Number of people participating in cross-border cooperation initiatives”. Project ROHU-202 contributed to this indicator by reaching a number of 134 people from the two communities situated on the shores of Mures River, as participants at the events organized.</p>
