Objective	The main objective of the project was to build cooperation and strengthen the relationships in the cross-border area of Oradea (RO) and Zsombó (HU), by creating a cross-border climbing league and organizing climbing events, in the context of small-case cooperation initiatives in the field of sports.

Summary	The aim of the ROHU-122 project was to increase the number of climbing enthusiasts and to create a favourable atmosphere by attracting sportsmen and women from the border region. The approach is new and goes beyond the existing practice in the programme area. The main activities implemented within the project: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • establishing of new cross-border climbing methods based on cooperation of institutions and communities (wall climbing will be promoted in schools of the Romanian-Hungarian frontier region);



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • organizing cross border climbing camp, for children with special needs from both sides of the Romanian-Hungarian area; • creating innovative climbing infrastructure; • organizing activities dedicated to pupils and students, to raise their awareness regarding the importance of practicing sports: school visits, training for 1 day/8 hours in school, abilities-testing. <p><i>On February 28, 2022, the project was successfully finalized. All activities provided in the project were completed (100%).</i></p> <p>The Programme Output Indicator is „11/b2 Number of people actively involved in cross-border cooperation initiatives”. Project ROHU-122 contributes to this indicator by reaching a number of 246 people from Romania and Hungary, participating in the activities of cross-border climbing.</p> <p>The collaboration of the partners within this project leads to an improvement of cooperation between civil organizations and between people in the cross-border area, through sports, by attracting sports people, children and students who have never encountered climbing as a sport.</p>
