Summary	development of tourism materials.
	 The main activities implemented within the project:: development of human resources, through 4 workshops and exchange of best practices between the 3 localities;





	 development of tourism infrastructure, through the acquisition of equipment and small-scale renovation works of the 3 touristic Infocenters in Jimbolia, Carpinis (both in RO) and Csanadpalota (HU), developing tourism materials, used in the promotion of the crossborder region (2700 brochures, 1900 CD album); developing a Joint tourism-promoting strategy organizing public meetings in Jimbolia, Carpinis and Csanadpalota with the participation of 30 persons from every locality
	On May 31, 2020, the project was successfully finalized. All activities provided in the project were completed (100%).
	The Programme Output Indicator is <i>"11/b1 Number of institutions directly involved in cross-border cooperation initiatives"</i> . Project ROHU-300 contributes by reaching a number of 3 institutions from Romania and Hungary that were directly involved in the cross-border cooperation.
	The partnership between the three local public administrations resulted in improved professional relationships and the establishment of appropriate tourist infrastructure, with an emphasis on promoting tourism in the region.
	The project's main results are:
Main results	 3 institutions from Romania and Hungary that were directly involved in the cross-border cooperation 9 persons from the 3 localities were formed through 4 workshops, 6 joint meetings and 3 public meeting 2 tourism information points renovated in Jimbolia, Carpinis and equipment for Csanadpalota's one; tourism promoting materials (brochures, albums, promotional film) for the project partners 3403 persons (1647 in person and 1756 persons online) were reached through project activities
