Summary	Project ROHU-315 improved the quality of life of local people and guests visiting the towns of Curtici (RO) and Pusztaottlaka (HU), by promoting a healthy lifestyle and sports practice.
	 The main activities are: Organizing 4 cross-border events, in Romania and Hungary, with cultural, artistic, and sport thematic sport contests between children's teams and adult teams (football, tennis, handball, karate); Organizing folk-dance competitions; Organizing culinary competitions;





	 Acquisition of necessary equipment: outdoor furniture, tents, catering equipment, football team equipment, folkloric costumes etc.; Rehabilitation of the sports bases in Curtici Town.
	On January 31, 2021, the project was successfully finalized. All activities provided in the project were completed (100%).
	The Programme Output Indicator is <i>"11/b2 Number of people participating in cross-border cooperation initiatives"</i> . Project ROHU–315 contributes by reaching a number of 1,298 participants, which will take part in the events of the project.
	The collaboration of the partners within this project allowed the promotion of the cultural, artistic and sports life within the local communities.
Main results	 The project's main results are: 1,298 participants in cross-border cooperation activities, organized in Romania and Hungary The sports base in Curtici renovated 4 events organized (2 in Pusztaottlaka and 2 in Curtici) encompassing a diverse range of activities including the preservation and dissemination of moral, artistic, and sporting values, backing of amateur bands, competitions, and festivals to encourage creativity and talent, culinary experiences, sports tournaments, and more.
