Summary	The project ROHU-316 organized different cultural activities for young and adult people, in order to help the population of the three localities to know better each other's local heritage and to raise the social cohesion in the border region. All activities provided in the project were completed (100%).</i></p> <p>The Programme Output Indicator is „11/b2 Number of people directly involved in cross-border cooperation initiatives”. Project ROHU-316 contributes to this indicator by reaching a number of 1,155 participants, taking part in the events.</p>
<p>Main results</p>	<p>The project's main results are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 1,155 people participating in cross-border activities - Summer Folk Dance Camp, organized in Jimbolia (RO), where participants learned folk dances and folk music, pottery, manufacture of leather objects, wood, embroidery, beads and wool - The Gastronomy festival organized in Carpinis. A number 76 persons were present at the event and 39 persons have participated in preparing the traditional food - 2 gastronomy events organized in Csanádpalota (HU), which consisted of preparing traditional dishes from the region and keeping an old tradition of the Hungarian Partner, called “<i>The International Böllérnap</i>”. The 2nd event involves the preparation of different types of sausages. This is an old, traditional event, held every winter in Csanádpalota. All partners have participated with their own teams.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Csanádpalota City Day were organized and all partners presented a cultural programme to promote their traditions.- 2 religious events organized in v lecea Mică and Cărpiniș, offering religious music and ceremonies to the people attending those events- A one-day children's festival organized in Csanadpalota. The festival was divided into 2 events, "Talleria" and the children's camp- The project cultural conference, organised in Jimbolia where the results of the project were presented and the participant experts exchanged experience and good practice
