Summary	The ROHU-128 project aimed to build 11.02 km of cycle paths in the Socodor-Kétegyháza cross-border area to reduce emissions from transport.
	The main activities implemented within the project:







 Kétegyháza (2.08 km); renovating 6 bus stations in Socodor, as part of the new greet transportation system set up in the frame of the project; setting up a combined bicycle track/ public transportation system between Socodor and Kétegyháza; purchasing 60 bicycles as part of the new green transportation system, and setting up 2 bicycle maintenance stations; organizing 2 cycling competitions, in Socodor and in Kétegyháza, order to ensure the promotion of the bicycle transportation system set up within the project; establishing a common regulation framework for the alternative cross-border green transport system, to support the increase in the use of bicycles as a means of transport. On April 30, 2022, the project was successfully finalized. All activities provided in the project were completed (100%). The Programme Output Indicator is "7/c 2 Total length of newly bubicycle roads".
