Summary	<p>Project ROHU-390 aimed to analyze and plan the public transport networks at the level of Oradea and Debrecen cross-border urban poles and to modernize the public transport services.</p> <p>The main activities implemented within the project:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Purchasing of 7 new buses with a reduced level of CO2 emissions (6 Euro 6 buses and 1 hybrid bus to be used by Oradea Local Public Transport Company (OTL) on 7 transport lines • Procuring of 2 midi-buses and 2 suburban Euro 6 buses to be used by Debrecen Transport Company on 4 transport lines; • Developing 1 Automatic Vehicle Location and passenger information system at the level of the city of Oradea; • Modernizing 3 public transport stops in the city of Debrecen through the procurement of real-time information panels and automatic tickets vending machines;
